We're just getting started! We have an excellent universal report server that will likely meet your needs for years to come, but we're not sitting back and waiting for the competition to catch up. We have a long list of enhancements we're planning for future releases, and we expect to release upgrades two to three times per year for years to come.

Let's get the legalese out of the way: Nothing in this document implies a legal commitment to deliver any of these features in any particular timeframe. This list is not complete and our priorities are customer-driven, so we may change when a feature will be delivered, drop a feature from a future release, or even drop an existing feature from a future release. We may change the timeframe when an upgrade will be delivered. The list of enhancements to the product will only be accurate when the list is included with the released upgrade and published on our Try Now page. Everything else should be considered "knowledgeable speculation" and subject to change.

So what do we see coming up in our future? Our current release schedule looks like this:

Spring 2010: We plan a dot-release of the product to include improvements to the user features, including the often-asked-for "run on-demand" feature found in Crystal Server.

Fall 2010: Another dot-release of the product to include more improvements to the user interface, including support for more distribution capabilities and configuration control.

Spring 2011: The next major release, which will include support for other databases and European languages.

Fall 2011: A dot-release to provide support for cloud-based storage and support for more languages.

We're very open to suggestions for additional features! Many of these features were suggested to us by our test sites. If you want to become a test site for future beta releases, please let us know and we'll work with you to make that happen.
